



2019-20 DRESS CODE FOR PROFESSIONAL PREPARATORY STUDENTS (LEVEL E THRU LEVEL B)

As a Professional Preparatory student (Levels E through B), you are a representative of Chamberlain School of Ballet. Therefore, your image at the ballet studio, theaters, or any other venue that you appear at is important. Please present yourself accordingly.

Female Professional Preparatory students (**Level E**) are required to wear non-sheer, pink tights and a Motionwear leotard of their choice from the following list of styles and color numbers to all ballet technique, pointe, variations, and partnering classes as well as all rehearsals.

Any colored leotards are permitted for **Level D** for Saturday classes. This season, **Levels C and B** can wear a specific color to represent their level on Saturdays. **Level C** will be permitted to wear a cap sleeve leotard (Motionwear Style 2149) in the color Iris (498) or a cap sleeve leotard (Motionwear Style 2149) in the color Plum (470) on Saturdays only. **Level B** will be permitted to wear a cap sleeve leotard (Motionwear Style 2149) in the color Royal Blue (483) on Saturdays only.

All Chamberlain Ballet company members are required to have a Leotard Style 2643 in black (497) and have Capezio #9 mesh, seamed tights for all performances and appearances by September 1st.

Motionwear Leotards:

2643 (wide strap, princess seams, square back) - Required for all Chamberlain Ballet company members

2150 (3/4 sleeve)

2149 (cap sleeve) - Suggested for Level C & Level B Saturday classes

2524 (camisole with scoop back, princess seams)

2515 (basic camisole)

Colors

497 (black) - Required for ALL Chamberlain Ballet company members

505 (white)

482 (raspberry)

498 (iris)

472 (pale pink)

470 (plum) - Suggested for Level C Saturday classes

469 (teal)

483 (royal blue) - Suggested for Level B Saturday classes

494 (coral)

As ballet slippers are needing to be replaced, all female students are required to purchase and wear Bloch, leather, full-sole ballet slippers to all ballet classes and rehearsals. This is required as preparation to enhance the student's foot work as well as pointe work.

The Artistic Staff recommends Freed, Capezio, Bloch or Grishko pointe shoes and a flexible shank Russian Pointe shoes. Students are discouraged from purchasing Gaynor Minden pointe shoes.

No black tights, leg warmers, skirts, sweatpants, sweatshirts, plastic shorts, or t-shirts are to be worn during class. Leg warmers are permitted when injured. All female students must have their hair neatly secured in a bun or french twist.

Male Professional Preparatory students (all levels) must wear black tights with a white t-shirt tucked in or knotted at the waist, black or white Bloch leather, full-sole ballet slippers. All male students must have their hair neatly secured and face cleanly shaved.

Students are required to wear appropriate clothing at all times when entering and leaving the studio. NO leotards, tights, or dance shoes are to be worn outside.
